PRINTABLE MEASURING TAPE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Print the tape measure (see below)
- 2. Ensure the printed tape measure is accurate by using it to measure a United States dollar note (any denomination); a dollar is 6.125 inches in length. If you are off by .125 (1/8) inch or more, ensure you are printing **true to size** by checking your printing preferences (see below).
- 3. Carefully cut out all 8 pieces of the tape measure.
- 4. Connect each strip in order as indicated using clear tape tape both sides and ensure the overlap is behind the measurement side. Glue can be used, but is not recommended.
- 5. Check for accuracy with a ruler or yard stick, if available. Otherwise, spot check between taped pieces with a United States dollar bill to ensure final accuracy.

The goal is to print this tape measure true to size.
